**8 Week Program plus placement (April or May 2019 Start Date)**

**Program Info:**

Confederation College's Sawmill Worker program will offer a variety of instructional in topics related to sawmill operations. This 8-week program consists of in class theory and a placement component. The program has a unique flexible design as it's delivered in modules of learning, containing specialized training blocks.

**Sawmill Worker Program**

The program instructors will train participants in the specific learning modules:

- ☑ Module one: Introduction to Wood Products Industry
- ☑ Module two: Safety First
- ☑ Module three: Mill Processes

**Admission Requirements:**

All potential students must have a minimum of a Grade 12 education, be 18 years of age or older and fill out all of the appropriate application forms and assessments prior to training.

**Course Information:**

This course will run from Monday to Friday – 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. – for 12 weeks. Students will be provided all personal protective equipment (PPE).

**Evaluation:**

Students will be evaluated at the end of each section. Individual instructors will discuss evaluation procedures in their respective subject areas. Specific tests will be administered in WHMIS and First Aid. Students must meet attendance requirements. Grades for the Sawmill Worker program will be a credit or non credit.

**Credentials:**

At the successful completion of the program, participants will receive a Confederation College "Recognition of Achievement."

**This program will have a 4-week Life Skills component beginning before the program.**
