SCOPE

Under the direction of the Band Administrator, and in conjunction with the Health Department, the AZA Child and Youth Strategy Worker, will provide services to ensure effective prevention and awareness programming and services are implemented through the Child and Youth Strategy. This position will work directly alongside the Health department front line workers to ensure effective service delivery between the concurrent programs.

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

- Research and acquire sound knowledge of Community resources and cultivating Community relations.
- Develop a Community capacity work plan pertaining to enhancing the lives of Children and Youth.
- Develop and implement prevention and awareness programming to enhance the lives of Community members.
- Assist with mapping exercise to define and address gaps in services.
- Enhance existing Community based programming within the appropriate departments.
- Work alongside the AZA Health Programs to enhance the Communities current services.
- Work alongside the IFN Child and Youth Policy Project Advisor to enhance the Communities service delivery.
- Communicate with Children, Youth, Families, Community and Departments, collecting, analyzing, and presenting verbal and written information appropriately.
- Any other duties as instructed by the Band Administrator.
- Maintain confidential documents to ensure trust is established when dealing with Clients and Community.
